Dear Scouting Representative,

Alibamu Lodge 179 with the aid of the Huntingdon College faculty will be hosting a Merit Badge Day on September 11, 2010 on the campus of Huntingdon College. The program will be a one day event with the professors of Huntingdon College and other professionals in their fields directing the curriculum by their fields of study.

Within this packet, you will find the following items: scout registration form, adult registration form, insurance policy notification, and an information sheet. Each scout and adult wishing to participate should fill out the appropriate form(s) and mail them with payment to the Tukabatchee Area Council Service Center no later than September 2nd. If the applications are received after this date, a \$5.00 assessment fee will be charged for each application. Please note due to the limited resources, facilities, and safety conditions, there will be a "first come, first serve" basis.

In addition to Merit Badges, there will be an adult training class offered, and adults will be allowed to attend Merit Badge classes with their Scouts.

The fee for each youth participant will be \$13.00, and the cost for each adult will be \$10.00. This fee covers meals, an event patch, and needed materials for the merit badge programs. Each troop attending **MUST** have at least 1 adult attending as a leader. **For every four youth participants, one adult can attend at no extra cost with a can of non-perishable food.**

Also, I ask that each scout bring pen or pencil and paper because notes will need to be taken.

Insurance Policy

According to national policy set by the Boy Scouts of America, each troop is to have some form of troop insurance. Insurance is NOT included into the fee to attend the Merit Badge Day at Huntingdon College, and by signing the wavier, each individual and/or troop are/is assuming full responsibility to provide insurance. Late Registration: With the exception of substitutes, no late registration will be accepted after September 8, 2010.

Reminder: All scouts and adults should pre-register by September 2, 2010. After this date, a \$5.00 charge will be added. All registration will end September 8, 2010.

Participation Limit: All classes will be limited to ensure the best merit badge course can be provided to each participant. Due to these circumstances, the earlier the registration is made the better.

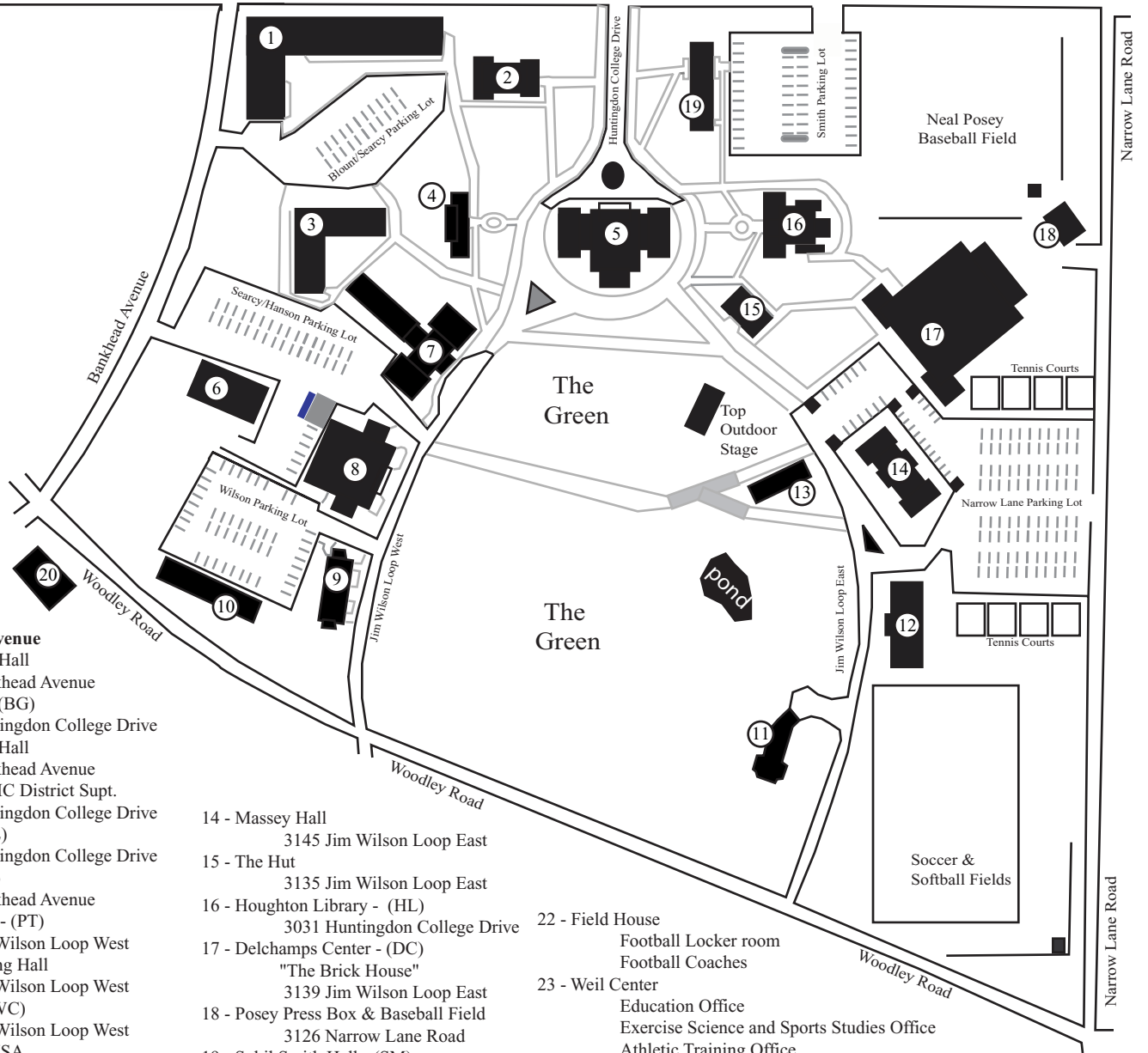
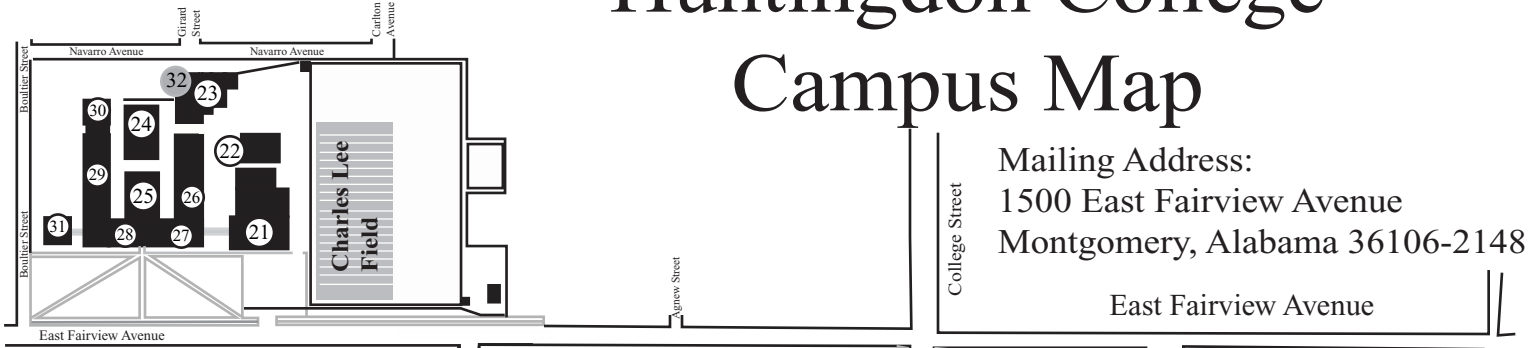
