



Alibamu Lodge 179 Adult Nomination



To be eligible for nomination to the Order of the Arrow, an adult must have 15 days and nights of camping including 6 days and 5 nights of long-term camping (only 1 long term campout may be applied) within the 2 years before the date of election.

Each year, upon holding a troop/crew election for youth candidates that results in at least one youth candidate being elected, the unit committee may nominate registered adults (age 21+) to the lodge adult selection committee. See the chart below for the number of adults allowed each year. Once approved by the adult selection committee candidates will be notified of their selection.
