


Ordeal Packing Instructions

Below you will find everything that is needed for the night of your Ordeal and how you can prepare this gear. Any other gear should be packed separately and will be set up at the location indicated at registration for use the next night. (BRING A TENT!)

Gear Needed In Your Horseshoe Pack:

- Sleeping bag & ground cloth
- Work clothes
- 3 foot piece of string/rope
- 8'x10' tarp or heavy plastic sheet to be used as a shelter in case of rain
- No other gear goes in your horseshoe pack!





Pack everything listed above inside your sleeping bag and then roll your sleeping bag with your tarp around it lengthwise and secure it with rope as shown here. This rope can be used to build your shelter if necessary.

Other Gear Needed, But NOT in Your Horseshoe Pack:

- Medication
- Water bottle
- Rain gear
- Copy of your BSA medical form that's not more than 12 months old. We need at least parts A & B (doctor visit not required for this).



In addition to the items listed you will need a complete Scout uniform and appropriate clothing and other regular camping gear.

You must bring a tent or hammock for Saturday night (be mindful about rain).
